

WERRINGTON ZONE SSSA CRITERIA FOR AWARDS

CHAMPION SCHOOL – Colyton High P&C Shield

Awarded annually to the school, which has contributed most significantly to the success of sport within the Werrington Zone.

The award will be judged on the Zone Point score, which is to be based on the Area Point score sheet for the W. J. Yong Trophy. Scoring sheets will be issued to all schools at the last general Zone meeting in Term 3. The top two schools as determined by the point score will be nominated for the Area award.

The criterion for the award is as follows:

1. **Contribution by Staff**

- Four (4) points for each member of staff who acts in the capacity of a Zone convener in a sport that conducts trials and attends an Area championship (carnival sports excluded).
- Four (4) points for each member of staff who is on the Zone executive.
- Four (4) points awarded if the school fulfils their staffing obligations at Zone carnivals

2. **Zone Competitions**

- Ten (10) points for each team that wins a Grade sport premiership (including joint premiers).
- Five (5) points for each team that is a Runner-up in a Grade sport premiership.

3. **School Performance at Carnivals**

- In each carnival (swimming, cross country, athletics) the following points apply:

4. **Age Champions**

- In each carnival (swimming, cross country, athletics) the following points apply:
Age Champion (including equal) Five (5) points
Age Runner-Up (including equal) Three (3) points
Third Age Champion (including equal) One (1) point

5. **Individual Representatives**

- Students who have represented the Zone/Area teams at other than carnival sports:
Zone Representative One (1) point
Area Representative Three (3) points

PRESIDENT’S AWARD

This award is made to the athlete who has made the most outstanding contribution to Zone Sport in a given year. The award recipient will have fulfilled the requirements for the award of a Zone Sporting Blue in AT LEAST TWO different sports in that year.

The Zone President is the sole judge of the recipient of the award.

Only ONE President’s Award will be awarded each year and the winner will receive a perpetual trophy to be held for one year. In addition they will receive a trophy to keep.

If no student in the Zone fulfils the requirements of the award, no award will be presented that year.

All nominations are to be sent directly to the Zone President.

ZONE SPORTING BLUE

This award is made to students who have made outstanding contributions to their chosen sport in OPEN COMPETITION at Sydney-West level or higher. The nominee must have also displayed behaviour that at all times was appropriate to the sport, being a good ambassador for both school and Zone.

The nominee must NOT have been previously awarded a Zone Blue in that particular sport.

The nominee must have:

1. Represented the REGION in a TEAM SPORT at OPEN level **OR**
2. Won an OPEN/17+ event at a AREA CARNIVAL or higher **OR**
3. Achieved the ALL TIME MOST OUTSTANDING PERFORMANCE in an individual event at AREA level or higher (e.g. set the fastest time in the 100 m of all time, even though they may have competed in a lower age group AND would have won the open/17+ event if eligible to compete in it).

The Nomination must also:

1. Have the endorsement of their school Principal **AND**
2. Be submitted by the due closing date for nominations to the award committee on the correct form **AND**
3. Have the endorsement of the Zone Convener for that sport **AND**
4. The nominated person must have no debts to the Zone – equipment or money.

ZONE RECOGNITION CERTIFICATE

This award is made to students who have made outstanding contributions in their chosen sport at other than open/17+ yrs competition at Area level, or in their chosen sport for several years, or in several sports in one year.

The nominee must also have displayed behaviour, which at all times was appropriate to the sport, being a good ambassador for both school and zone.

The nominee must NOT have previously been awarded a Zone Recognition Certificate in that sport. The nominee cannot be awarded a second Zone Recognition Certificate in the General category.

The nominee must have:

1. Represented Area in a team sport other than at open level **OR**
2. Won an individual event at Region level or higher **OR**
3. Represented Werrington Zone at the Area Championships on three (3) separate occasions in the same sport **OR**
4. Represented Werrington Zone at the Area Championships in three (3) separate sports in the same year **OR**
5. Given valuable service to sport in the Zone

The Nomination must also:

6. Have the endorsement of their school Principal **AND**
7. Be submitted by the due closing date for nominations to the award committee on the correct form **AND**
8. Have the endorsement of the Zone Convener for that sport(s) **AND**
9. The nominated person must have no debts to the Zone – equipment or money.
